



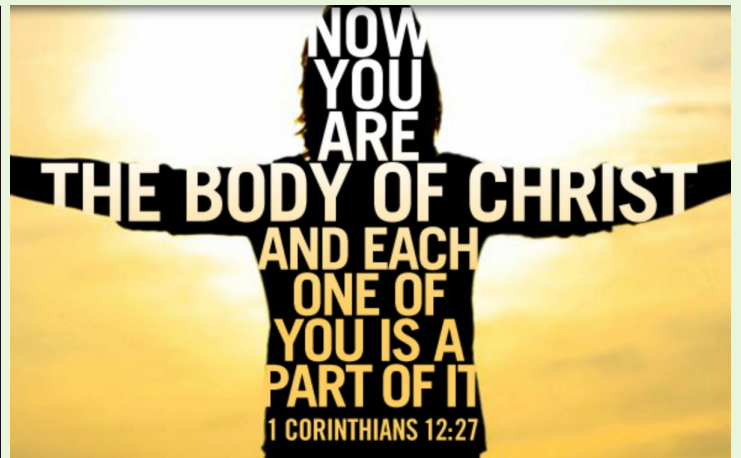
The 2nd Sunday after Trinity

The 1st Reading - 1 Corinthians 12:12-18,27

¹²For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. ¹³For in the one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and we were all made to drink of one Spirit. ¹⁴Indeed, the body does not consist of one member but of many. ¹⁵If the foot were to say, 'Because I am not a hand, I do not belong to the body', that would not make it any less a part of the body. ¹⁶And if the ear were to say, 'Because I am not an eye, I do not belong to the body', that would not make it any less a part of the body. ¹⁷If the whole body were an eye, where would the hearing be? If the whole body were hearing, where would the sense of smell be? ¹⁸But as it is, God arranged the members in the body, each one of them, as he chose. Now you are the body of Christ and individually members of it.

The 2nd Reading - John 15:9-17

⁹As the Father has loved me, so I have loved you; abide in my love. ¹⁰If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love. ¹¹I have said these things to you so that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be complete. 'This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends. You are my friends if you do what I command you. I do not call you servants any longer, because the servant does not know what the master is doing; but I have called you friends, because I have made known to you everything that I have heard from my Father. You did not choose me but I chose you. And I appointed you to go and bear fruit, fruit that will last, so that the Father will give you whatever you ask him in my name. I am



giving you these commands so that you may love one another.

Today's Psalm (Evensong) - 43

Give sentence with me O God, and defend my cause against the un/godly / people : O deliver me from the de/ceitful and / wicked / man.

For thou art the God of my strength, why hast thou / put me / from thee : and why go I so heavily, while the / enemy op/presseth / me? O send out thy light and thy truth that / they may / lead me : and bring me unto thy holy / hill and / to thy / dwelling.

And that I may go unto the altar of God, even unto the God of my / joy and / gladness : and upon the harp will I give thanks unto / thee O / God my / God.

Why art thou so heavy / O my / soul : and why art thou / so dis/quiet•ed with/in me?

O put thy / trust in / God : for I will yet give him thanks, which is the help of my / countenance / and my / God.
